Lycée BRISTOL Cannes



The lycée Bristol was established in 1934 and is conveniently located in the centre of the city. In 1996 the building of the lycée was completely renovated in the style of the big hotels of the French Riviera.

The facilities include the main building, a sports hall, science laboratories building and are surrounded with a large park.

In addition to the classrooms the main building houses language laboratories, a film studio, a school theatre, a photo laboratory, a library and a school restaurant.

The following lessons are being taught:
French, History, Geography, English, Maths, Physics, Economics, Social studies, Literature, Philosophy, Spanish, German, Italian, Technology, Sport (volleyball, table tennis de table, gymnastics, athletics...).
