

## Program OPUS 6 & 9



Combining an English language program with a paid work placement makes for an affordable and effective learning experience. With the OPUS program, your integrated studies and work placement will allow you to practice your language skills with native speakers in a real-life work situation.

You will be placed in a paid placement 8 weeks after the start of your program. All positions are in the Customer Service/Retail industry in Vancouver. You will work part-time during your studies (16 – 20 hours per week) and during vacation periods.

### This program is right for you if:

- Your goal is to improve your English skills in a Customer Service/Retail environment
- You can stay in Canada for at least 26 weeks (program lengths vary)
- You are over 18
- You are looking for a more affordable learning experience

### Program Structure

#### Opus 6

Program includes 8 weeks of full-time studies + 16 weeks of full-time studies/part-time work + 2-4 weeks vacation\* (see dates)

#### Opus 9

Program includes 8 weeks of full-time studies + 24 weeks of full-time studies/part-time work + 3-5 weeks vacation\* (see dates)
