General school information

This school is a unique secondary school dedicated to developing each student's special talents and abilities. It makes a concerted effort to give individual attention to each student. As an English-speaking school in Spain, there is much diversity. The school exposes its pupils to the advantages of technology at an early age. Sports at this school are also especially strong. The school encourages physical well-being as well as teamwork and self-confidence.

Campus

This school is 23 km from the city of Valencia. Valencia is a very exciting city that enjoys mild temperatures and many hours of sunlight all year round, making possible numerous outdoor events, such as concerts and its famous fireworks displays. Valencia's visitors may enjoy in its rich heritage by visiting its many monuments. One of them, "La Lonja" was declared an International Heritage Site. The Museum of Modern Art, "El Ivam", hosts many exhibits, including one of the largest exhibitions in modern art. Close to the concert hall is the "City of Arts and Sciences" which is a new complex considered to be one of Europe's best centers for cultural and leisure activities.

In addition to the fantastic sites described, Valencia offers some of the largest Spanish beaches and many family run restaurants to enjoy the best known Spanish dish: "Paella", the traditional Valencian meal

School Location

This school is only 3km from the Mediterranean Sea. The 27.000m² campus is located in a privileged area of Valencia, surrounded by palm and orange trees.

Languages

All subjects are taught in English, except for four subjects that are taught in Spanish. German and Valencian (local language) are also offered as optional subjects..



School facilities
