Accommodation

In simply-furnished student residences throughout the year, plus more comfortable air conditioned residences in summer. From the accommodation to the ALP is no more than a 10-minute walk.

Accommodation note:

The precise accommodation available for summer is only known very shortly before the course. Priority is given in order of booking date. If you booked late, and there is a difference between the accommodation you booked and that which is actually available, any difference of price will be regulated by the university with a local refund or surcharge.
